1. Introduction

Many thanks for your interest in Datchet Golf Club; a club founded in 1890 and described in Today's Golfer as, "*One of the UK's finest 9 Hole Course*".

Datchet is a very friendly and relative informal club with a very active roll-up programme and a full calendar of fun events and club competitions for both men and women.

The roll-ups are a mainstay of the club and a great way to get to know the other members. Any playing member with a handicap can turn up to any of the roll-ups and play (subject to any limitations their category of membership imposes). For those without a handicap, we can organise playing partners to mark a card for you to obtain one.

Our golf course features diverse layouts and stunning views of Windsor Castle. Although a 9-hole course, it has 15 different tee positions which provide substantially different front and back 9s. It is suitable for players of all skill levels and offers both challenge and enjoyment.

In addition to a practice putting green by the clubhouse and nets by the 18th green, we have a 500-yard grass practice area which is the ideal venue to utilise every club in your bag.

Tuition is available from the Club Professional at discounted rates for members.

2. Membership Categories and Guests

The benefits of membership vary by membership category.

- (i) Full Members**
Full members are entitled to enjoy the whole range of amenities at the Club.
- (ii) Five Day Members**
Five Day members may play golf Monday to Friday inclusive. They may however use the Club at all times.
- (iii) Colt Members**
Members of 18 years of age or over and in full time education. They are entitled to enjoy the whole range of amenities at the Club.
- (iv) Intermediate Members**
Members between 18 and 34 years of age and not in full time education. They are entitled to enjoy the whole range of amenities at the Club.
- (v) Junior Members**
Members under the age of 18. They are entitled to enjoy the whole range of amenities at the Club.
- (vi) Country Members**
Members permanently residing not less than 50 miles radius from the Club. Country members may not play in Club competitions.
- (vii) Social Members**
Social members may use the Clubhouse facilities but must pay green fees to play golf.

(viii) Associate Members

Associate members may play golf Monday to Friday inclusive, but limited to the number of rounds they have subscribed to. They may however use the Club at all times. Provided no Club Medal, Competition or Match is being played, Associate members may play the course after 2pm on Saturdays and Sundays during British Summer Time and after 12 noon on Sundays during British Winter Time, but limited to the number of rounds they have subscribed to. Such days will be indicated in the Club calendar.

(ix) 9-hole Members

9-hole members are entitled to enjoy the whole range of amenities at the Club but may only play 9-holes per day.

(x) Six-month

Six-month members are entitled to enjoy the whole range of amenities at the Club but may not play in Club Competitions.

(xi) Pathway Members

Pathway membership includes 6 one-hour lessons and 10 rounds of 18 holes.

Members are encouraged to bring guests. Guest green fees are discounted from the visitor rates.

Reciprocal arrangements are available through the 1890 Club, of which Datchet is a member. This is a group of 22 clubs across the country all founded in 1890. Some of these clubs will offer courtesy of the course to DCG members, although a few will levy a reduced green fee.

Additionally, if you register as a Berks, Bucks and Oxon member (free to all DGC members), you can obtain discounted rates at all affiliate courses.

3. Introductory Offers

We are currently offering several introductory offers. These are solely at the discretion of the club and maybe varied or withdrawn at any time. Any offer cannot be combined with any other offer.

Two-for-one offer conditions

1. The two-for-one offer applies to the Full, Five-Day, Intermediate, Associate, 9-Hole and Six-month membership categories.
2. A new member is defined as any person who is not currently a member (in any category) and has not been a member in the 18 months prior to (re)joining (a “New Member”)
3. The discounted membership subscription applies to the first membership period only.
4. To be eligible to receive the discount, two New Members must join and pay the first-year invoice in full at the same time.
5. The offer provides a full discount to the lower membership subscription for two new members joining at the same time. For example, for two Full Members, the discount will be a Full membership subscription. For a Full Member and an Intermediate Member, the discount will be the Intermediate Member subscription. One New Member will be charged the Full subscription plus extras, the other New member will be charged only the extras; it is up to the New Members how the discount is then split.
6. The discount applies to the Membership subscription only. i.e. it does not included extras such as locker fee, Golf Union level, tags/swipe card etc.

Back to golf offer

Any New Member paying the full annual subscription in entitled to six 1-hour lessons with the Datchet Golf Club Professional, Paul Cook, within the first year of membership.

Military Personnel Offer

Any current member of the armed forces is entitled to a 20% reduction of the Full or Intermediate rate each year. If two members join under the two-for-one offer, the 20% discount will only apply to subsequent years.
